

What can be collected?

Card/Cardboard

✓ Flattened card/cardboard. Individual items no bigger than box lid.

✗ **NO** wet, unflattened or dirty card/cardboard. No plastic windows, cardboard drinks cartons, takeaway pizza boxes or commercial card/cardboard.



Cans – Food & Drinks

✓ Rinsed food and drinks cans, aerosol cans and biscuit/sweet tins.

✗ **NO** cans containing paint.



Plastic Bottles

✓ Any plastic bottle, rinsed and squashed. Plastic bottle tops, if still attached to bottle.

✗ **NO** other type of plastic, e.g. plastic trays, yoghurt pots etc.



Paper

✓ Newspapers, magazines, junkmail, catalogues, brochures and office paper.

✗ **NO** envelopes or plastic wrapping.



Glass – Bottles & Jars

✓ Rinsed glass bottles and jars.

✗ **NO** ceramics, light bulbs or broken glass.



Clothes

✓ Clothes, shoes (in pairs) and bedding material. Tie in a separate bag please.

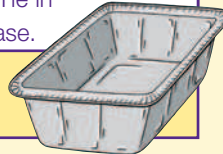
✗ **NO** duvets, dirty or wet clothes.



Foil

✓ Clean aluminium foil, e.g. milk bottle tops, foil trays etc. Tie in a separate bag please.

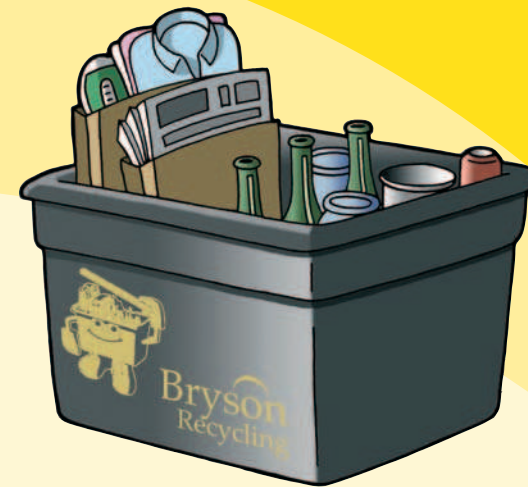
✗ **NO** dirty foil or crisp bags.



Hand Tools

✓ Old hand tools (saws, hammers, chisels and pliers).

✗ **NO** power tools.



Where is it collected from?

Please leave your box for collection at the front of your property, as close to the pavement as possible, where it can be clearly seen by our collection crews.

When is it collected?

Put your box out by 7.30am on your collection day.

Closure dates

There will be no collections on the following public holidays:

Easter Monday & Tuesday
July 12th & 13th
Christmas Day & Boxing Day
New Years Day
